PRESS RELEASE re: Frogwell EEC

On January 6th 2017, our Early Excellence Centre at Frogwell was judged to be an Outstanding Early Years setting. Hannah Lovell, our EEC manager, and her team, are delighted with this recognition for all their dedication to the children in their care.

The inspector, Charlotte Jenkin, recognised that teaching is of a consistently high quality and takes account of children's individual learning needs. In particular noting that staff are highly skilled at supporting the children. It also acknowledges that the manager expertly introduces new ideas for improvement and therefore the children are keen to learn and can concentrate well.

We are all delighted that the children were seen to be “very settled and secure in the setting - playing well together cooperatively and show they learn to develop respect for their friends.”

On July 5th 2016 The RISE Early Excellence Centre at Charter also had an Ofsted inspection and this was judged to be an outstanding pre-school too. Charter EEC was recognised for its outstanding safeguarding practice and the staff's excellent teaching.

Both of The RISE inspections highlight that all staff have high regard for the children's well-being and work extremely closely with relevant agencies, and parents, to ensure children are kept safe.
